

Oregon State University, School of Civil and Construction Engineering is recruiting for full/part-time Instructors to teach on a term by term basis for the 2011-2012 academic year. These are fixed-term appointments, w/renewal at the discretion of the School Head. Courses to be taught may include construction engineering management, geotechnical engineering, ocean and coastal engineering, structural engineering, surveying, transportation engineering, and water resources engineering for the School of Civil and Construction Engineering. Salary is commensurate education and experience. Required qualifications include a Master's in Civil or Construction Engineering or related discipline. Demonstrated knowledge and ability to teach a course in the subject/field of instruction. Preferred qualifications include PhD in Civil or Construction Engineering or related discipline. Professional experience related to civil or construction engineering practice. Teaching experience at a College or University level. A demonstrable commitment to promoting and enhancing diversity.
